Happy July, Tree of Life family! I hope and pray that you are staying cool and getting to enjoy a "different" pace during these summer months. It is my prayer that we all take opportunities to slow down and be present throughout these summer weeks. It is also a great time for us to slow down and to crack open God's word on a regular basis and to let its truth inform our actions, our attitudes, our words, and our relationships.

One of our Christian traditions that I have come to love over time is our lectionary schedule. Say what, pastor? Let me explain. Our Bible passages that we read every Sunday are actually predetermined so that in a matter of 3 years, we will have read through a majority of the Old and New Testament. For the last 2 months of June through the end of October we will be reading through the Gospel of Luke together on Sunday. One of the upcoming stories is found in Luke 10:38-42. I encourage you to open up your Bible and to read these few, short verses now.

It changes for me and I am guessing it does for you too. I had a very recent reminder of how I have a lot of Martha in me. I started focusing on the wrong things and took my eyes off Jesus. When I do this, it never goes well for me. I become overwhelmed, irritable, and selfish in these moments. Thank goodness Jesus is always right there to forgive me and to welcome me back to sit at his feet and to spend time in His presence, listening to His always loving and truthful words.

Re-read with me Luke 10:41-42a, "But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, but one thing is







Every year in Maun, the rivers dry up for a few months. Then, when the water from the rains in the Angola highlands makes its way here, our rivers fill up again. You can imagine the excitement that comes with the river! Fresh water! Life! Happy crops, happy livestock, and happy people. This year, for the first time, we were able to watch the river trickle in. What a joyful occasion! How much more refreshing is the River of Life that never dries up and quenches the soul's deepest thirst!

Right now, Carl is in South Africa working with a cross-border cooperative group to revise the 1970 version of the Setswana Bible. Since there are Setswana speakers in both Botswana and South Africa, scholars from both countries are contributing to the revision.

June featured several exciting events at school (not to mention lots of exams). Book Character day: each kid dressed up like a favorite book character. We also had a walk-a-thon, an international food night, and a pajama day.

The house we rent is on the grounds of Thuso Rehabilitation Center. It offers physical and vocational rehabilitation. It is owned (as is our house) by the Lutheran church. The center is going through major changes, some of which will affect us. Pray with us for God's will to be done!
