# Grulke Bible Translators in Botswana

Collaboration and New Beginnings

June was a very exciting month for Bible translation in Botswana. Carl saw a big vision come to fruition. He dreamed up, got funding for, planned, and executed a southern Africa regional Bible translation summit. Organizations came together in an unprecedented way to collaborate, share ideas, and create a vision for a more united future for Bible translation in southern Africa. We are praising God for the summit's success. We finished the second and final round of proofreading for the Shekgalagari New Testament. The typesetters made the final adjustments, and now the manuscript is at the printer. This is a huge milestone that we are thanking God for.

After a year of training, preparations, and set-up, the Botswana Sign Language translation team has officially been launched! We have been providing technical support for them. Join us in praying for them as they continue their great work.

After attending the translation summit, LBT regional director, Sarah Esala paid us a visit. We talked strategy with her and our colleagues from another part of Botswana. We are thankful for her discernment and keen eye towards the future.

Thank you all for praying for our new residence permits to come through. We received them just in time for our old ones to expire. Unfortunately, we were only given two years, and we were hoping for five. Pray for wisdom as we deal with this uncertainty.
